

RESOLUTION NO. 1994- 150

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CUMMINS OHIO, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF 40 REBUILT LT10 DIESEL ENGINES FOR A PRICE OF \$350,000.00 - CAPITAL GRANTS OH-90-0134 AND OH-90-0204 (\$170,400.00 FROM OH-90-0134 AND \$109,600.00 FROM OH-90-0204 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL) AND 20% LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1987-331 the Board of Trustees authorized a contract for the purchase of 77 40-foot Flexible coaches with Cummins LT10 diesel engines; and

WHEREAS, due to oil-related problems these engines have experienced premature failure; and

WHEREAS, Cummins Ohio, Inc., on September 16, 1994, offered to provide 40 reconditioned LT10 diesel engines at a price of eight thousand four hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$8,400.00) each plus damaged core charges, to resolve any and all issues between the parties with respect to the premature failures; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems acceptance of said offer to be in the best interest of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Cummins Ohio, Inc. dated September 16, 1994 be accepted.


Section 2. That the General Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cummins Ohio, Inc. for the purchase of 40 reconditioned LT10 diesel engines at a unit price of eight thousand four hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$8,400.00) each plus damaged core charges.

Section 3. That said contract shall be paid out of Capital Grants OH-90-0134 and OH-90-0204 (\$170,400.00 from OH-90-0134 and \$109,600.00 from OH-90-0204 in Federal Funds which represents 80% of the total) and 20% Local Match, for the total amount of three hundred fifty thousand & 00/100 dollars. (\$350,000.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
