

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-151

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH VEHICLE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR THE FURNISHING OF MOTOR COACH FILTERS, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$86,455.50 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT).**

WHEREAS, the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program located at 622 Hungerford Drive, Suite #5, Rockville, MD 20850, for the furnishing of motor coach filters, as specified and as required, was received on the 21st day of September, 1994, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of eighty-six thousand four hundred fifty-five & 50/100 dollars (\$86,455.50); and

WHEREAS, this procurement is divisible; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program for Item Numbers 1 (GCRTA No. 81-950-Fram), 3 (GCRTA No. 82-13000-Wix), 5 (GCRTA No. 81-20001-Fram), 6 (GCRTA No. 81-20002-Fram), 13 (GCRTA No. 87-20127-Fram), and 14 (GCRTA No. 81-34000-Detroit) of IFB No. 94080 to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for these items and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program for Item Numbers 1, 3, 5, 6, 13, and 14 of IFB No. 94080 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Vehicle Maintenance Program for the furnishing of motor coach filters, Item Numbers 1, 3, 5, 6, 13, and 14 of IFB No. 94080, as specified and as required, for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) in an estimated amount not to exceed eighty-six thousand four hundred fifty five & 50/100 dollars (\$86,455.50).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
