

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-158

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO CONTRACT NO. 92114 WITH A.G. LICHTENSTEIN & ASSOCIATES, INC. TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT 20 - REHABILITATION OF THE CUYAHOGA VIADUCT AND TWO TRACK BRIDGES ON THE REDLINE AND JOINT OPERATING AREA WHICH EXPANDS THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL DESIGN WORK TO CORRECT DETERIORATION AT A PRICE OF \$7,129.00, CAPITAL GRANT OH-23-9001 (\$6,059.65 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 85% OF THE CHANGE ORDER COST)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution No. 1993-5 authorized Contract No. 92114 in the amount of six hundred twenty two thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$622,000.00) with A.G. Lichtenstein located at 5880 Sawmill Road, Dublin, Ohio 43017 to provide engineering services for Project 20, Rehabilitation of the Cuyahoga Viaduct and two track bridges on the Redline and joint operating area; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has previously approved sixty two thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$62,000.00) which combined with the original contract amount makes the current contract price six hundred eighty four thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$684,000.00); and

WHEREAS, changes to the specification requirements have resulted due to unforeseen conditions which require additional design work to correct the advanced deteriorated state of some of the structural members discovered during inspection at a cost of \$7,129.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to execute a change order in the amount of seven thousand one hundred twenty nine & 00/100 dollars (\$7,129.00) in order to accomplish said changes to the specifications requirements.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby fully reauthorized to execute this change order authority pursuant to the GCRTA Procurement Policy Manual for purposes of this contract.

Section 3. That the total amount authorized for said contract is amended to be six hundred ninety one thousand one hundred twenty nine & 00/100 dollars (\$691,129.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1994-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
