

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DOMINIC CALABRESE CEMENT CONTRACTING, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR PROJECT 18J & K - REHABILITATION OF THE W. 33RD ST./BROOKPARK AND E. 130TH ST./CORLETT BUS LOOPS AT A PRICE OF \$534,975.00 (\$427,980.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE COST)

WHEREAS, the bid of Dominic Calabrese, Cement Contracting, Inc. located at 700 E. 165th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44110 for the rehabilitation of the W. 33rd St./Brookpark and E. 130th St./Corlett Bus Loops was received on October 27, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Dominic Calabrese Cement Contractors, Inc. submitted an offer to perform the construction services for project 18J & K - Rehabilitation of the W. 33rd St./Brookpark and E. 130th St./Corlett Bus Loops at a cost of five hundred thirty-four thousand nine hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$534,975.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Dominic Calabrese Cement Contracting, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Dominic Calabrese Cement Contractors, Inc. for the provision of construction services for the rehabilitation of the W. 33rd St./Brookpark and E. 130th St./Corlett Bus Loops, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Dominic Calabrese Cement Contractors, Inc. to provide construction services for Project 18J & K - Rehabilitation of the W. 33rd St./Brookpark and E. 130th St./Corlett Bus Loops.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-X179 in the amount of five hundred thirty-four thousand nine hundred seventy five & 00/100 dollars (\$534,975.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
