

**AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 91154
WITH GLAZEN ADVERTISING FOR THE PROVISION OF
ADVERTISING SERVICES TO THE AUTHORITY (NOT TO
EXCEED \$650,000.00 - GENERAL FUND - MARKETING
DEPARTMENT BUDGET)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 1992-22 the Authority entered into Contract 91154 with Glazen Advertising for the provision of advertising services to the Authority for a period of up to three (3) years at a price not to exceed one million two hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$1,200,000.00); and

WHEREAS, additional advertising services beyond estimates were budgeted for and utilized in 1992 and 1993; and

WHEREAS, said contract has been increased by a total of four hundred twelve thousand five hundred seventy-six & 00/100 dollars (\$412,576) by Resolution 1994-83 and under the General Manager's authority for a total contract price of one million six hundred twelve thousand five hundred seventy-six and 00/100 dollars (\$1,612,576).

WHEREAS, the Marketing Department has estimated that it will require an additional six hundred fifty thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$650,000.00) to fund this contract through its scheduled completion date of February 28, 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to increase the price of Contract No. 91154 with Glazen Advertising for the provision of advertising services.

Section 2. That said increase shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount not to exceed six hundred fifty thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$650,000.00).

Section 3. That the total contract value shall not exceed two million two hundred sixty-two thousand five hundred seventy-six & 00/100 dollars (\$2,262,576.00).

Section 4. That the change order authority of the General Manager under the Procurement Policy is hereby re-authorized.

Section 5. That all other contract terms and conditions shall remain unchanged.

Section 6. That this amendment shall be binding upon and an obligation to the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and compliance by the contractor to the contract specifications and addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
