

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-184

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BROWN DESIGN ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR ARCHITECT/ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT 31 - A.D.A. COMPLIANCE ACCESSIBILITY OF TEN (10) KEY STATIONS (\$670,000.00 - OF WHICH 80% (\$536,000.00) IS FROM CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0136)

WHEREAS, the proposal of Brown Design Associates, Inc. located at P.O. Box 2565, Atlanta, Georgia 30301 for Architect/Engineering Services for Project 31 - A.D.A. Compliance Accessibility of ten (10) Key Stations was received on the 5th day of August 1994; and

WHEREAS, Brown Design Associates, Inc. submitted an offer to provide Architect/Engineering Services for Project 31 - A.D.A. Compliance Accessibility of ten (10) Key Stations at a price of six hundred seventy thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$670,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems Brown Design Associates, Inc., to be the most qualified provider of the required Architect/Engineering Services and finds the negotiated price to be reasonable and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Brown Design Associates, Inc., on August 5, 1994 be and the same is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for Architect/Engineering Services for Project 31 - A.D.A. Compliance Accessibility of ten (10) Key Stations at an estimated price of six hundred seventy thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$670,000.00).


Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Brown Design Associates, Inc., dated August 5, 1994 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That this contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0136, Line Item 12.14.20.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
