

Resolution NO. 1994 -190

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO MAKE AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE GEORGE GUND FOUNDATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING A SERIES OF PROFESSIONAL ASSISTANCE WORKSHOPS RECOMMENDED BY THE ARTS IN TRANSIT COMMITTEE FOR ARTISTS

WHEREAS, The George Gund Foundations, has grant funds for governmental agencies which emphasize artistic quality, innovative public art programs and focus on artistic growth. The Foundation encourages collaboration among arts organizations and supports the economic, educational and cultural development of Cuyahoga County.


WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Arts In Transit Program qualifies for available grant funds to provide professional assistance workshops to develop and strengthen artists' skills, in proposal writing, making formal presentations of art work and submitting art proposals supportive of engineering and construction designs and organizational budgets. The workshops are a collaboration between the RTA Arts In Transit Committee, the Cleveland Institute of Art, The Committee for Public Art, and NOVA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make application for funding from the The George Gund Foundation, and to execute any and all necessary documents in conjunction with said application.

Section 2. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees.
