

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN TRACK SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF DIRECT RAIL FIXATION RAIL FASTENERS, AS SPECIFIED FOR THE WATERFRONT TRANSIT LINE, PROJECT 32T3 FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$208,757.50 (CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - 100% LOCAL FUNDS).

WHEREAS, the bid of American Track Systems located at 73 East Forrest Avenue, Suite 13, Shrewsbury, PA 17361 for the furnishing of direct rail fixation rail fasteners, as specified for the Waterfront Line, Project 32T3 was received on November 15, 1994 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of two hundred eight thousand seven hundred fifty-seven & 50/100 dollars (\$208,757.50); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of American Track Systems, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of American Track Systems, Inc. for the furnishing of direct rail fixation rail fasteners, as specified for the Waterfront Line, Project 32T3 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with American Track systems, Inc. for the furnishing of direct rail fixation rail fasteners, as specified for the Waterfront Transit Line, Project 32T3.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the GCRTA Capital Improvement Fund - 100% Local funds in an amount not to exceed two hundred eight thousand seven hundred fifty-seven & 50/100 dollars (\$208,757.50).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
