

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 94055 WITH PRECISION DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR PROJECT 4.91 - EAST 105TH ST. BRIDGE EAST SIDEWALK REPAIR \$17,000.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND (ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION)

WHEREAS, Resolution 1994-126, adopted August 23, 1994, authorized a contract with Precision Design & Construction, Inc. for Project 4.91 - East 105th St. Bridge East Sidewalk Repairs at a price of sixty-five thousand four hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$65,450.00); and

WHEREAS, deterioration beyond the measurements contained in original scope of work was found on the bridge resulting in the need for additional work and materials; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Authority to have Precision Design & Construction, Inc. perform the additional work; and

WHEREAS, a price adjustment of seventeen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$17,000.00) is required to complete the anticipated work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Precision Design & construction, Inc. at a price of seventeen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$17,000.00) resulting in a revised contract amount of eighty-two thousand four hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$82,450.00).

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby re-authorized to exercise his full Change Order authority under GCRTA Procurement Policy, Section I-4.2.7.2, applied to the Precision Design & Construction, Inc. contract for Project 4.91.


Section 3. That said contract amendment shall be payable out of RTA Capital Fund, in a total amount not-to-exceed seventeen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$17,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
