RESOLUTION NO. 1994- 223

AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PERHANENT "FAMILY FARE"

WHEREAS, Resolution 1993-1 specified that up to three children under six (6) years of age may ride free when accompanied by an adult paying the applicable fare; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of Resolution 1993-1, children six years of age and older currently pay the full fare; and

WHEREAS, the policy of charging full fares to children six years of age and older makes using RTA very expensive for families traveling together; and

WHEREAS, RTA's summer 1994 "family fare" promotion had a positive revenue impact; and

WHEREAS, establishing a permanent "family fare" category in RTA's fare structure will enable more families to ride RTA to community events and other destinations, thus increasing ridership on RTA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will establish a permanent "family fare," effective January 1, 1995.

Section 2. That the "family fare" shall provide that an adult together with up to three children ages six (6) through fifteen (15), may ride RTA for a sum equal to the applicable adult fare plus one-dollar (\$1.00).

Section 3. That, except as provided in Section 2, children six (6) years of age and older will continue to pay the fares established in Resolution 1993-1.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
