

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-1

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH 32 FORD/MERCURY, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE (3) CARGO VANS THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$63,615.00 - \$50,461.00 FROM CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0078 (\$40,369.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST) AND \$13,154.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND, FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT .

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H)(4), permits a regional transit authority to participate in the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of three (3) cargo vans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority is authorized to enter into a contract with 32 Ford/Mercury, Inc., 610 West Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103, for the purchase of three (3) cargo vans as specified in term contract GDC-93-E in the amount of sixty-three thousand six hundred fifteen & 00/100 dollars (\$63,615.00).

Section 2. That said contract be payable out of the Capital Grant OH-90-0078, in the amount of fifty thousand four hundred sixty-one & 00/100 dollars (\$50,461.00) and RTA Capital Fund in the amount of thirteen thousand one hundred fifty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$13,154.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by 32 Ford/Mercury, Inc. with the terms of the contract, compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; the specifications and addenda, if any; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
