

RESOLUTION NO. 1995 -10

AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE METROHEALTH SYSTEM FOR THE PROVISION OF ADA ELIGIBILITY EVALUATION SERVICES (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00) GENERAL FUND, COMMUNITY/CUSTOMER RELATIONS DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 306.43 (H)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code the purchase of goods or services from another public agency is exempt from the competitive procurement process; and

WHEREAS, The MetroHealth System is a public agency of Cuyahoga County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, The MetroHealth System has offered to provide to the Authority services in evaluating applications and determining the eligibility of applicants for Paratransit services under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, at a cost not to exceed one hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$100,000) for a one year period; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems acceptance of the offer of The MetroHealth Systems to be in the best interest of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The MetroHealth System to provide services in evaluating applications and determining the eligibility of applicants for Paratransit service under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.


Section 2. That the price of said contract shall not exceed one hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$100,000.00).

Section 3. That the cost of said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Community/Customer Relations Department budget.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by The MetroHealth System with the terms of the contract compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
