

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-18

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO CONTRACT NO. 94126 WITH COYNE TEXTILE SERVICES FOR THE FURNISHING AND CLEANING OF UNIFORMS (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$175,733.00) GENERAL FUND, FRINGE BENEFITS ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, by labor agreement with the Amalgamated Transit Union #268 provides certain employees with work uniforms; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 1993-38 authorized a contract with Coyne Textile Services to provide six uniforms per employee in an amount not to exceed two hundred ninety-nine thousand six hundred twenty-two & 96/100 dollars (\$299,622.96) for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the most recent collective bargaining agreement, the number of the uniforms supplied to employees increased from six to ten; and

WHEREAS, the increased number of uniforms will cost the Authority an additional amount estimated at one hundred seventy-five thousand seven hundred thirty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$175,733.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to increase the contract with Coyne Textile Services for the furnishing and cleaning of uniforms by the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand seven hundred thirty-three & 00/100 (\$175,733.00).


Section 2. That the total amount of said contract shall not exceed four hundred seventy-five thousand three hundred fifty-five & 96/100 dollars (\$475,355.96).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Fringe Benefits Account.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by Coyne Textile Services with the terms of the contract compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
