RESOLUTION 1995 - 27

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO CONTRACT NO. 94121 WITH URS CONSULTANTS FOR PLANNING SERVICES FOR A CLEVELAND-AKRON COMMUTER RAIL LINE (EST \$24,000 - LOCAL MATCH FUND)

WHEREAS, the General Manager, pursuant to the authority delegated to him under the Authority's Procurement Policy, entered into Contract No. 94121 with URS Consultants, to perform planning services in connection with a proposed commuter rail line between Cleveland and Akron; and

WHEREAS, Agreement has been reached among the State of Ohio Department of Transportation, the Akron Metro Transit Authority, and the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority to perform similar services in connection with Metro Regional Transportation Authority's participation in the commuter rail project; and

WHEREAS, The general Manager deems the performance of these services under Contract No. 94121 to be in the best interest of the Authority pursuant to said Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and hereby is authorized to amend Contract No. 94121 with URS Consultants to provide additional planning services in connection with Metro Regional Transit Authority's participation in a proposed commuter rail between Cleveland and Akron.

Section 2. That the price of said contract be increased by twenty-four thousand and no/100 dollars (\$24,000), and that the total price of said contract not to exceed forty-eight thousand two hundred and no/100 dollars (\$48,200.00).

Section 3. That said increase be payable out of of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund, reimbursable by Metro Regional Transit Authority.

Section 4. That all other terms and conditions of Contract No. 94121 remain unchanged.

Section 5. That this resolution be effective immediately upon its adoption.
