

RESOLUTION NO. 1995- 31

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH B.P. AMERICA FOR THE FURNISHING OF DIESEL FUEL FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR, (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,088,657.00 - GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of B.P. America located at 200 Public Square, 11-B, Cleveland, Ohio 44114 for the furnishing of diesel fuel was received on the 24th of February, 1995 for a price of three million eighty-eight thousand six hundred fifty-seven & 00/100 dollars (\$3,088,657.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of B.P. America to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of B.P. America received on February 24, 1995 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and hereby authorized to enter into a contract with B.P. America for the furnishing of diesel fuel as required and as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General in an amount not to exceed three million eighty-eight thousand six hundred fifty-seven & 00/100 dollars (\$3,088,657.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance of the contractor to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
