

RESOLUTION NO. 1995- 51

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 95004 WITH NATIONAL PAPER & PACKAGING COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF PAPER PRODUCTS, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$51,561.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of National Paper & Packaging Company located at 1240 East 55th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44103 for the furnishing of paper products, as specified and as required was received on the 2nd day of March 1995, for the unit prices set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of fifty-one thousand five hundred sixty-one & 00/100 dollars (\$51,561.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of National Paper & Packaging Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of National Paper & Packaging Company for the furnishing of paper products, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with National Paper & Packaging Company for the furnishing of paper products, as required, for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget), at the unit prices stated for an estimated amount not to exceed fifty-one thousand five hundred sixty-one & 00/100 dollars (\$51,561.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
