

RESOLUTION 1995- 53

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COLEJON CORPORATION FOR PROJECT 34, PHASE VI - SITE PREPARATION, FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF PASSENGER SHELTERS, \$437,591.00 - CAPITAL GRANTS OH-90-X166, \$241,996.00 AND OH-90-X222, \$195,595.00 (\$350,073.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST)**

WHEREAS, the bid of ColeJon Corporation located at 13836 Union Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44120 in the amount of four hundred thirty-seven thousand five hundred ninety-one and 00/100 dollars (\$437,591.00) was the low bid received for Project 34 on April 3, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of ColeJon Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of ColeJon Corporation for the provision of construction services for the site preparation, fabrication, and installation of passenger shelters, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with ColeJon to provide construction services for site preparation, fabrication, and installation of passenger shelters.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grants OH-90-X166, \$241,996.00 and OH-90-X222, \$195,595.00 in the amount of four hundred thirty-seven thousand five hundred ninety-one and 00/100 dollars (\$437,591.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
