

RESOLUTION NO. 1995 - 63

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TYRONE GETER FOR THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF ART AT THE SUPERIOR RAPID STATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,000.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104, LINE ITEM 12.34.02 (\$23,250.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE COST).

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, by Resolution 1991-172 established the Arts-in-Transit program for the purpose of implementing a program to integrate art into various public transit facilities;

WHEREAS, on January 5, 1994, Tyrone Geter of 544 Vinita Avenue, Akron, Ohio 44320-1911, submitted an offer to design and install art for the Rapid Station at a price of thirty-one thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$31,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the proposal of Tyrone Geter on January 5, 1994, as modified by negotiations, for art design and installation at the Superior Rapid Station be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous for the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio;

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Tyrone Geter on January 5, 1994, as modified by negotiation for art design and installation at the Superior Rapid Station be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous for the Authority.


Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Tyrone Geter dated January 5, 1994, as modified by negotiations.

Section 3. That this contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0104, Line Item 12.34.02 in the amount of thirty-one thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$31,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of trustees in Resolution No. 1993-98; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
