

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-85

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ANCHOR CLEANING CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF WINDOW, BUILDING, AND CANOPY CLEANING, AS SPECIFIED, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS, (AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$128,784.00 - GENERAL FUND), FACILITIES MAINTENANCE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Anchor Cleaning Contractors, Inc. located at 1966 W. 52nd Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44102 for the furnishing of window, building, and canopy cleaning, as specified, for a period of two (2) years was received on the 12th of May, 1995 for the price set forth in said bid, involving a total amount of one hundred twenty-eight thousand seven hundred eighty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$128,784.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Anchor Cleaning Contractors, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Anchor Cleaning Contractors, Inc. for the furnishing of window, building, and canopy cleaning, as specified, for a period of two (2) years be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Anchor Cleaning Contractors, Inc. for the furnishing of window, building, and canopy cleaning, as specified, for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount not to exceed one hundred twenty-eight thousand seven hundred eighty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$128,784.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation for future contract years and compliance of the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
