

RESOLUTION NO. 1995 -90

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 95058 WITH THE SWIGER COIL SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE REBUILDING OF RAPID TRANSIT ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT, AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS (AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$491,287.00 - GENERAL FUND), RAIL EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the bid of Swiger Coil Systems, Inc., located at 4677 Manufacturing Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44135 for the rebuilding of rapid transit electrical equipment was received on the 17th day of May, 1995, for a price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of four hundred ninety-one thousand two hundred eighty-seven & 00/100 dollars (\$491,287.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Swiger Coil Systems, Inc., as modified by negotiations, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Swiger Coil Systems, Inc. for a total price of \$491,287.00 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Swiger Coil Systems, Inc. for the rebuilding of rapid transit electrical equipment for a period of two (2) years.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Rail Equipment Department budget) in an amount not-to-exceed four hundred ninety-one thousand two hundred eighty-seven & 00/100 dollars (\$491,287.00).

Section 4. That said contract is subject to FTA approval of a waiver of Buy America requirements for certain motors.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and in obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the scope of work; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
