

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-95

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TRANSTECH OF S.C., INC. FOR PANTOGRAPH RETROFITS, AS SPECIFIED FOR THE WATERFRONT TRANSIT LINE, PROJECT 32H1, \$667,558.00 - CAPITAL GRANTS OH-03-0054, \$136,000.00; OH-90-0078, \$231,250.00; AND OH-90-X166, \$120,000 (\$389,800.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 58% OF THE TOTAL COST), AND \$180,308.00 (CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - 100% LOCAL FUNDS).**

WHEREAS, the bid of Transtech of S.C., Inc. located at 196 Old Augusta Road, Piedmont, S.C., 29673 for pantograph retrofits, as specified for the Waterfront Line, Project 32H1 was received on June 2, 1995 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of six hundred sixty-seven thousand five hundred fifty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$667,558.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Transtech of S.C., Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Transtech of S.C., Inc. for the pantograph retrofits, as specified for the Waterfront Line, Project 32H1 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Transtech of S.C., Inc. for the pantograph retrofits, as specified for the Waterfront Transit Line, Project 32H1.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Grants OH-03-0054, OH-90-0078, and OH-90-X166; and GCRTA Capital Improvement Fund - 100% Local funds in an amount not to exceed six hundred sixty-seven thousand five hundred fifty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$667,558.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
