

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-109

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH R.P. CARBONE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR PROJECT 24C - REHABILITATION OF WINDERMERE RAPID STATION - \$12,692,000.00 (CAPITAL GRANTS OH-03-0097 AND OH-03-0128 - \$9,728,600.00, WHICH REPRESENTS APPROXIMATELY 77% OF THE TOTAL PRICE)

WHEREAS, the bid of R.P. Carbone Construction Company located at 5885 Landerbrook Drive, Suite 110, Cleveland, Ohio 44124 for the furnishing of construction services for Project 24C - Rehabilitation of Windermere Rapid Station was received on the 6th day of July 1995 for a price set forth in said bid of twelve million six hundred ninety two thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$12,692,000.00), and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of R.P. Carbone Construction Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of R.P. Carbone Construction Company received on July 6, 1995 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with R.P. Carbone Construction Company for the furnishing of construction services necessary to complete Project 24C - Rehabilitation of Windermere Rapid Station at a price of twelve million six hundred ninety-two thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$12,692,000.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grants OH-03-0097 and OH-03-0128, Line Item #12.34.02 in amounts not to exceed twelve million six hundred ninety-two thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$12,692,000.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
