

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-113

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 95039 WITH JDJ&A, INC. FOR ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT NO. 35 - DESIGN OF CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY TRANSIT CENTER (\$655,365.66) CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X222 (\$524,292.52) IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL PRICE

WHEREAS, the proposal of JDJ&A, Inc. located at 2162 Front Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221 for Architect/Engineering Services for Project 35 - Design of Cleveland State University Transit Center was received on the 24th day of April 1995; and

WHEREAS, JDJ&A, Inc. submitted an offer to provide Architect/Engineering Services for Project 35 at a price of six hundred fifty five thousand three hundred sixty five and 66/100 dollars (\$655,365.66); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems JDJ&A to be the most qualified provider of the required Architect/Engineering Services and finds the negotiated price to be reasonable, and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by JDJ&A, Inc. be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for Architect/Engineering Services for Project 35 - Design of Cleveland State University Transit Center at a negotiated price of six hundred fifty five thousand three hundred sixty five & 66/100 dollars (\$655,365.66).

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of JDJ&A, Inc. dated April 24, 1995 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-90-X222 in the amount of six hundred fifty-five thousand three hundred sixty-five & 66/100 dollars (\$655,365.66).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1994-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
