

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-143

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 95091-A WITH SUN COMPANY, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF 15 w-40 ENGINE OIL, IN DRUMS AND BULK, AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SIX & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$137,496.00 GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Sun Company, Inc., located at 1801 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103, for the furnishing of engine oil, in drums and bulk, as required for a period of two (2) years was received on the 21st of September, 1995, for the unit prices set forth in said bid of one hundred thirty-seven thousand four hundred ninety-six & 00/100 dollars (\$137,496.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Sun Company, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Sun Company, Inc. received on September 21st, 1995 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sun Company, Inc. for engine oil, in drums and bulk, as required for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the (General Fund, Inventory Department Budget), at the unit prices stated, for an estimated amount not to exceed one hundred thirty-seven thousand four hundred ninety-six & 00/100 dollars (\$137,496.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
