

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-160

**AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 95094 WITH VEHICLE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR THE FURNISHING OF MOTOR COACH FILTERS, AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX & 00/100 (\$39,556.00 - GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET).**

WHEREAS, the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program located at 622 Hungerford Drive, Suite #5, Rockville, MD 20850, for the furnishing of motor coach filters, as specified and as required, was received on the 10th day of October, 1995 for the unit prices set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of thirty-nine thousand five hundred fifty-six & 00/100 dollars (\$39,556.00); and

WHEREAS, this procurement is divisible;

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program for Item Numbers 1, 3, 6, and 9 of IFB No. 95094 to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program received on October 10, 1995 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for Item Numbers 1, 3, 6, and 9.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Vehicle Maintenance Program for motor coach filters, Item Numbers 1, 3, 6, and 9 of IFB No. 95094, as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Inventory Department Budget, at the unit prices stated for an estimated expenditure of thirty-nine thousand five hundred fifty-six & 00/100 dollars (\$39,556.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
