

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-166

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH CONLEY, CANITANO & ASSOCIATES, INC. TO PROVIDE DATA BASE ADMINISTRATION SERVICES TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT BY \$49,010.00 - GENERAL FUND, INFORMATION SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority requires an administrator in the Information Systems Department to ensure that the Oracle data base runs as smoothly as possible; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is in the process of hiring a permanent data base administrator; and

WHEREAS, Conley, Canitano & Associates, Inc. has provided a data base administrator to the Authority approved under the General Manager's delegated authority for small purchase contracts for twenty-four thousand nine hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$24,900.00); and

WHEREAS, additional funding is required to continue said services; and

WHEREAS, said increase will cause the total contract amount to exceed the General Manager's delegated authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Conley, Canitano & Associates, Inc. for data base administration services to increase the contract price by forty-nine thousand ten & 00/100 dollars (\$49,010.00), to a total amount not-to-exceed seventy-three thousand nine hundred ten & 00/100 dollars (\$73,910.00).


Section 2. That the hourly rates and other terms of the contract shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. That said increase shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by Conley, Canitano & Associates, Inc. with the terms of the contract, compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88, the specifications and addenda, if any; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
