

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-175

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 95125 WITH BURKE-PARSONS-BOWLBY CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF RAILROAD TIMBER TIES FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$58,080.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND - POWER DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation located at P. O. Box 231, Route #21, Ripley, West Virginia 25271, for the furnishing of railroad timber ties was received on the 1st day of December, 1995, for the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of fifty-eight thousand eighty & 00/100 dollars (\$58,080.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation for the furnishing of railroad timber ties, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation for the furnishing of railroad timber ties.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund, Power Department Budget in a total amount of fifty-eight thousand eighty & 00/100 dollars (\$58,080.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
