AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 95121 WITH CLEVELAND HERMETIC & SUPPLY, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF REFRIGERANT GAS (R-22), AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$26,775.00 (RTA GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Cleveland Hermetic & Supply, Inc. located 7724 Detroit Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44102 for the furnishing refrigerant gas R-22, was received on the 27th of November, 1995 for a price set forth in said bid of twenty-six thousand seven hundred seventy-five dollars (\$26,775.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Cleveland Hermetic & Supply, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Cleveland Hermetic & Supply Inc. received on November 27, 1995 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cleveland Hermetic & Supply Inc. for the furnishing refrigerant gas (R-22), as specified, for a period of one year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of RTA General Fund in an amount not to exceed twenty-six thousand & seven hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$26,775.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance of the contractor to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
