RESOLUTION NO. 1996-16

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO CONTRACT NO. 93001 WITH MULTISYSTEMS, INCORPORATED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL MODIFICATIONS TO AN AUTOMATED CUSTOMER INFORMATION SYSTEM AND AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT RELATED SYSTEM AT A PRICE OF \$76,018.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0113 (\$57,013.50 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE TOTAL).

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution 1993-163 authorized Contract No. 93001 for the development and installation of an integrated customer/geographic information system and paratransit scheduling system, compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act, in the amount of one million one hundred sixty-nine thousand nine hundred eighteen & 00/100 dollars (\$1,169,918.00) with Multisystems, Incorporated, located at 1050 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, MA 02138-5381; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager previously approved an increase of one hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$100,000.00) for assessment of the entire Authority's computer network requirements in order to incorporate those needs into the software design and additional network modifications; and

WHEREAS, changes sought by the Authority have resulted in additional costs for modifications to the specifications, equipment and training in the amount of seventy-six thousand eighteen & 00/100 dollars (\$76,018.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to execute a change order in the amount of seventy-six thousand eighteen & 00/100 dollars (\$76,018.00).

Section 2. That the total amount authorized for said contract is amended to be one million three hundred forty-five thousand nine hundred thirty-six & 00/100 dollars (\$1,345,936.00) for modifications to the specification, equipment and training.

Section 3. That all other provisions of said contract shall remain unchanged.

Section 4. That the General Manager's change order authority for the contract is reinstated.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
