

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-26

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ACTION DOOR COMPANY FOR PROJECT 5.70 - OVERHEAD DOOR REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE, AS REQUIRED AND SPECIFIED, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS BEGINNING APRIL 1, 1996 FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED (\$260,000.00 - GENERAL FUND) - FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the bid of Action Door Company located at 10779 Brookpark Rd., Parma, Ohio 44130 for the repair and maintenance of overhead doors, as required and specified, for a period of three (3) years beginning April 1, 1996 was received on the 6th of March, 1996, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated amount not to exceed two hundred sixty thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$260,000.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Action Door Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Action Door Company be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Action Door Company for the repair and maintenance of overhead doors, as required and specified, for a period of three (3) years beginning April 1, 1996.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Facilities Maintenance Department Budget) in an amount not to exceed two hundred sixty thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$260,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
