

RESOLUTION NO. 1996 -45

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 95119 WITH CHEMICAL SOLVENTS, INC. TO PROVIDE SOLVENT REPLACEMENT SERVICES, AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$167,748.00 (GENERAL FUND, BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the proposal of Chemical Solvents, Inc. located at 3751 Jennings Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, to provide solvent replacement services for parts wash tanks to the Authority for a period of two (2) years was received on February 15, 1996; and

WHEREAS, negotiations with Chemical Solvents, Inc. resulted in an offer at a price not to exceed one hundred sixty-seven thousand seven hundred forty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$167,748.00) for the two year period of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer of Chemical Solvents, Inc., as modified through negotiations, to be the most advantageous to the Authority, price and all other factors considered, and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the negotiated offer of Chemical Solvents, Inc. be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous to the Authority, price and other factors considered, to provide solvent replacement services for parts wash tanks for a period of two (2) years.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chemical Solvents, Inc. for the furnishing of solvent replacement services for parts wash tanks for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal dated February 15, 1996, as modified by negotiations.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Bus Equipment Department budget) in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty-seven thousand seven hundred forty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$167,748.00).

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the negotiated scope of work and addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
