

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-97

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 96072 WITH C.A.M. CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF HIGH SPEED MAINLINE CIRCUIT BREAKERS ASSEMBLY FOR BRED A LIGHT RAIL VEHICLES (IN THE AMOUNT OF \$142,000.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND - RAIL EQUIPMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, The bid of C.A.M. Co., located 667 Industrial Park Road, Ebensburg, Pennsylvania for the furnishing of high speed main line circuit breakers for Breda LRV's was received on the 5th day of August, 1996, for the price set forth in said bid, of one hundred forty-two thousand dollars (\$142,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of C.A.M. Co. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland, Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of C.A.M. Co. for a total price of \$142,000.00 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with C.A.M. Co. for the furnishing of high speed mainline circuit breakers for Breda LRV's.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund (Rail Equipment Department Budget) in the amount of one hundred forty-two thousand dollars (\$142,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon FTA waiver of Buy America requirements; and upon compliance by the contractor to the scope of work; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and FTA waiver of Buy America Requirements.
