

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-100

AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT #96097 WITH CUMMINS OHIO, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF THIRTY (30) REMANUFACTURED CUMMINS L10 DIESEL ENGINES FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$375,637.50 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X270 (\$300,509.76 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE COST) BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that it is in the best interest of the Authority to purchase thirty (30) remanufactured Cummins L10 diesel engines; and

WHEREAS, to assure that these engines are EPA compliant, they must be purchased from Cummins Ohio, Inc., 7585 Northfield Road, Cleveland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43 (H)(2) provides that competitive bidding is not required when a purchase consists of goods or services or any combination thereof, and after reasonable inquiry the Board or any officer or employee the Board designates finds only one source of supply reasonably available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

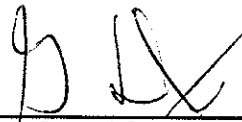
Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cummins Ohio, Inc. for the purchase of thirty (30) remanufactured Cummins L10 diesel engines at a unit price of \$12,521.25, for a total expenditure of three hundred seventy-five thousand six hundred thirty-seven & 50/100 dollars (\$375,637.50).

Section 2. That said contract will be payable out of the Capital Grant OH-90-X270 in the amount of three hundred seventy-five thousand six hundred thirty-seven & 50/100 dollars (\$375,637.50).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the terms of the contract, compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
