RESOLUTION NO. 1996 -101

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO CONTRACT 93122 WITH COLEJON CORPORATION FOR THE PROVISION OF CLEANING SERVICES FOR BUS SHELTERS (\$130,000.00) GENERAL FUND, FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 1994-14, the Colejon Corporation was authorized to provide shelter cleaning services in an amount not to exceed five hundred thirty thousand nine hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$530,920.00); and

WHEREAS, due to extensive rewrite of specifications to include new services, it is necessary to extend the contract time and increase funding for this contract; and

WHEREAS, prusuant to his delegated authority, the General Manager approved an increase in the amount of \$100,000.00 and extended the time of performance of this contract; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to add an additional \$130,000.00 to continue services until October 1, 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to increase contract 93122 with the Colejon Corporation by the sum of one hundred thirty thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$130,000.00).

Section 2. That the total amount of said contract shall not exceed seven hundred sixty thousand nine hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$760,920.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Facilities Maintenance budget.

Section 4. That the General Manager's change order authority for the contract is reinstated.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the Colejon Corporation with the terms of the contract, compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
