AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1995-192 TO PROVIDE FOR AN APPROPRIATION IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,523.44.

WHEREAS, RTA is involved with the multi-jurisdictional Caribbean/Gang Task Force.

WHEREAS, RTA derives revenue from seized and confiscated monies and/or properties of convicted drug dealers prosecuted by the Task Force.

WHEREAS, guidlines instituted by the State Attorney General's office restricts the use of these funds of law enforcement purposes.

WHEREAS, RTA received a disbursement from the Caribbean/Gang Task Force in March 1995 of \$86,211.20 which they have not completely expended at this time.

WHEREAS, the Transit Police Department intends to use the remainder of these funds for law enforcement purposes including Information Systems and Training.

WHEREAS, no appropriation was made in the 1996 budget as this revenue was unexpected.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:
