

RESOLUTION NO. 1996 -110

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 96088 WITH ARTISAN CLEANING CO., INC. FOR THE THE PROVISION OF CLEANING TO THE GATEWAY ACCESSWAY FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS (IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED OF \$90,390.00 - GENERAL FUND), RAIL OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Artisan Cleaning Co., Inc. located at 1135 Riverside Drive, Painesville, Ohio 44077 for the provision of cleaning to the Gateway Accessway for a period of two (2) years was received on the 26th day of August, 1996, for a price set forth in said bid, involving an amount of ninety thousand three hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$90,390.00); and

WHEREAS, the bid of Artisan Cleaning Co., Inc. was the only responsive bid received; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Artisan Cleaning Co., Inc. to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Artisan Cleaning Co., Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$90,390.00 be and the same is hereby accepted as a responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Artisan Cleaning Co., Inc. for the provision of cleaning to the Gateway Accessway for a period of two (2) years.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General fund (Rail Operations Department budget) in an amount not-to-exceed ninety thousand three hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$90,390.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the scope of work; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
