

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-111

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT #96083 WITH JONES TECHNOLOGIES ENTERPRISES CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF PASSENGER SHELTER CLEANING FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS AT A PRICE NOT-TO-EXCEED \$1,088,800.00 (GENERAL FUND - FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc., located at 6153 Cedar Court, Solon, Ohio 44139, for the furnishing of passenger shelter cleaning for a period of two (2) years was received on the 9th of September, 1996, at the unit price set forth in said bid for a total price not-to-exceed one million eighty-eight thousand eight hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$1,088,800.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc. to be the sole responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc. received on the 9th of September, 1996 be and the same is hereby accepted as the sole responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc., for the furnishing of passenger shelter cleaning for a period of two (2) years, as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Facilities Maintenance Department budget, in an amount not-to-exceed one million eighty-eight thousand eight hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$1,088,800.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and in obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the scope of work; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
