

RESOLUTION NO. 1996- 115

**AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 96085 WITH PENN MACHINE COMPANY
FOR THE FURNISHING OF STEEL WHEELS FOR THE BRED A LIGHT
RAIL VEHICLES FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$400,200.00
(GENERAL FUND - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)**

WHEREAS, the bid of Penn Machine Company located at 106 Station Street, Johnstown, PA 15904 for the furnishing of steel wheels for the Breda light rail vehicles was received on the 26th of August, 1996 for a price set forth in said bid of four hundred thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$400,200.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Penn Machine Company, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Penn Machine Company received on 26th day of August, 1996 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Penn Machine Company for the furnishing of steel wheels for the Breda light rail vehicles, as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Inventory Department Budget in an amount not to exceed four hundred thousand, two hundred & 00/100 (\$400,200.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance of the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
