RESOLUTION NO. 1996 - 119

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY FROM THE BROADWAY AREA HOUSING COALITION, INC., AN OHIO NON-PROFIT HOUSING CORPORATION, OF FEE SIMPLE TITLE TO A PARCEL OF REALTY LOCATED AT TURNEY ROAD AND ELLA AVENUE, IN CLEVELAND, OHIO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A BUS LOOP, DRIVEWAY, BUS DRIVERS' LAVATORY, AND PASSENGER SHELTER AREA ON THE REALTY.

WHEREAS, the Broadway Housing Coalition, Inc., an Ohio non-profit housing corporation, has proposed that it gift a parcel of realty located in Cleveland, Ohio, to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority for the purpose of the Authority constructing a bus loop, driveway, bus drivers' lavatory, and passenger shelter area on the realty; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will benefit from the acceptance of such gift from the Broadway Area Housing Coalition, Inc., and thus desires to accept the gift of realty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority that:

Section 1: The proposal of the Broadway Area Housing Coalition, Inc., of Cleveland, Ohio, an Ohio non-profit housing corporation, to make a gift of a parcel of realty located at the south-east corner of Turney Road and Ella Avenue in Cleveland, Ohio, consisting of .4821 acres and designated as Permanent Parcel No. 134-17-002 to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority for the purpose of the Authority constructing a bus loop, driveway, bus drivers' lavatory, and passenger shelter area on the realty, is hereby accepted.

Section 2: The General Manager be and is hereby directed to execute on behalf of the Authority all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

Course I Thence continuing North 43° 02' 36" East, 28.76 feet to a point;


Course If Thence North 76° 33' 51" East, 125.77 feet to a point;
