

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-136

**AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT #96119 WITH KNOX WESTERN FOR THE FURNISHING OF A SERVICE CONTRACT FOR THE CNG COMPRESSORS AT HARVARD GARAGE AND WOODHILL GARAGE FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$219,000.00 FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS**

WHEREAS, the proposal of Knox Western located at 111 Bacon Street, Erie, PA 16511 for the furnishing of a service contract for the CNG compressors at Harvard Garage and Woodhill Garage was received on the 10th of September, 1996, for a price set forth in said proposal of two hundred nineteen thousand dollars (\$219,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43(H) provides that the competitive bidding is not required when the purchase consists of goods or services or any combination thereof, and after reasonable inquiry the Board or any officer or employee the Board designates finds that only one source of supply is reasonably available; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer of Knox Western to be the lowest responsive offer from a responsible offeror and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Knox Western for the furnishing of a service contract on the CNG compressors at Harvard Garage and Woodhill Garage, as specified.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount not to exceed two hundred nineteen thousand & 00/100 (\$219,000.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance of the contractor to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
