

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-169

**AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 96127 WITH MUNCIE RECLAMATION AND SUPPLY COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF CATALYTIC CONVERTER/MUFFLER KITS, AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$97,784.11 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)**

WHEREAS, the bid of Muncie Reclamation & Supply Company, located at 3720 South Madison Street, Muncie, Indiana 47302, for the furnishing of catalytic converters/muffler kits, as required, was received on the 18th day of November, 1996, for the unit prices set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of ninety-seven thousand seven hundred eighty-four & 11/100 dollars (\$97,784.11); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Muncie Reclamation & Supply Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Muncie Reclamation & Supply Company for the furnishing of catalytic converters/muffler kits, as required for a period of one (1) year, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Muncie Reclamation & Supply Company for the furnishing of catalytic converters/muffler kits, as required, for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget), at the unit prices stated for an estimated amount not to exceed ninety-seven thousand seven hundred eighty-four & 11/100 dollars (\$97,784.11).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
