

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-6

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 96139A WITH 32 FORD MERCURY, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF FOUR (4) TRANSIT POLICE VEHICLES AND PERIPHERAL EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$84,056.00, CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X270 (\$67,244.80 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE COST).

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H)(4), permits a regional transit authority to participate in the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of four (10) transit police vehicles and peripheral equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is authorized to enter into a contract through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program with 32 Ford Mercury, Inc., 610 West Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103, for the purchase of four (4) transit police vehicles and peripheral equipment as specified.

Section 2. That the price of said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-90-X270, in the amount of eighty-four thousand fifty-six & 00/100 dollars (\$84,056.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123, bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
