

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-28

**AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 96142 WITH UNION SWITCH & SIGNAL, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF EIGHT IMPEDANCE BONDS, AS SPECIFIED, FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$36,272.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)**

WHEREAS, the bid of Union Switch and Signal, Inc. located at 645 Russell Street, Batesburg, SC 29006 for the furnishing of eight impedance bonds, as specified was received on the 13th of January, 1997, for a price set forth in said bid of thirty-six thousand two hundred seventy-two dollars (\$36,272.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Union Switch and Signal, Inc. to be the sole responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Union Switch and Signal, Inc. received on January 13, 1997 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Union Switch and Signal, Inc. for the furnishing of eight impedance bonds, as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of RTA General Fund, Inventory Department budget in an amount not to exceed thirty-six thousand two hundred seventy-two & 00/100 dollars (\$36,272.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance of the contractor to Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
