

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-146

RATIFYING \$55,002.00 OF THE GENERAL MANAGER'S APPROVED CHANGE ORDERS, AND APPROVING ADDITIONAL CHANGE ORDERS OF \$117,300.00 FOR A TOTAL INCREASE OF \$172,302.00 TO CONTRACT NO. 92018 WITH PARSONS ENGINEERING SCIENCE, INC. FOR PROJECT 300B, SOIL REMEDIATION AT HAYDEN GARAGE RTA CAPITAL FUND - \$90,000.00 AND CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X222 - \$27,300.00 (\$21,840.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS, WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF GRANT TOTAL AND 23% OF THE TOTAL COST - ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1992-150, the Board of Trustees authorized the General Manager to enter into a contract with Parsons Engineering Science, Inc., 19101 Villaview Road, Cleveland, Ohio 4419, for soil remediation at Hayden Garage at a price of five hundred sixty-eight thousand four hundred ninety-seven dollars & 00/100 (\$568,497.00);

WHEREAS, the General Manager approved change orders with a total cost of fifty-five thousand two & 00/100 dollars (\$55,002.00) to cover continuing soil remediation and additional technical support services for the project; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional soil remediation and technical support at a negotiated price of one hundred seventeen thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$117,300.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the change orders approved by the General Manager to Contract No. 92018 with Parsons Engineering Science, Inc. for a total cost of fifty-five thousand two & 00/100 dollars (\$55,002.00) be and hereby are ratified.

Section 2. That additional change orders at a total price of one hundred seventeen thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$117,300.00) be authorized for a total revised contract cost of seven hundred forty thousand seven hundred ninety-nine & 00/100 dollars (\$740,799.00).

Section 3. That the General Manager's change order authority pursuant to Section I.4.2.7.2 of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Procurement Policy and Procedures is reauthorized for this procurement action.

Section 4. That all other terms and conditions of the original contract remain unchanged.


Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
