## **RESOLUTION NO. 1997 - 155**

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1996-179 TO PROVIDE FOR AN APPROPRIATION IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,424,99.

WHEREAS, RTA is involved with the multi-jurisdictional Caribbean/Gang Task Force.

WHEREAS, RTA derives revenue from seized and confiscated monies and/or properties of convicted drug dealers prosecuted by the Task Force.

WHEREAS, guidelines instituted by the State Attorney General's office restricts the use of these funds for law enforcement purposes.

WHEREAS, RTA received a disbursement from the Caribbean/Gang Task Force in March 1995 of \$86,211.20 which they have not completely expended at this time.

WHEREAS, the Transit Police Department intends to use the remainder of these funds for law enforcement purposes to purchase bulletproof vests.

WHEREAS, no appropriation was made in the 1997 budget as this expenditure was unexpected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:
