## **RESOLUTION NO. 1997- 157**

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 97088 WITH BRASCO INTERNATIONAL FOR PROJECT 41, PHASE VII - PROVISION AND INSTALLATION OF PASSENGER SHELTERS - \$681,220.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X222 (\$544,976.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL).

WHEREAS, the bid of Brasco International located at 8750 Grinnell Street, Detroit, Michigan 48213 for the provision and installation of passenger shelters was received on July 17, 1997 in the amount of seventeen hundred fifteen thousand nine hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$715,900.00); and

WHEREAS, the bid of Brasco International was the sole bid received; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code 306.43(b)(5), a negotiated price was achieved in the amount of six hundred eighty one thousand two hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$681,220.00) for the single bid received on Project 41, Phase VII; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Brasco International to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Brasco International for the provision and installation of passenger shelters under Project 41, Phase VII as modified by negotiations be and the same is hereby accepted as a responsible bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Brasco International to provide and install passenger shelters under Project 41, Phase VII.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of RTA Capital Grant OH-90-X222 in the amount of six hundred eighty one thousand two hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$681,220.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

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Section 5. This authorization is contingent upon approval of Capital Grant OH-90-X222, by the Federal Transit Administration.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
