RESOLUTION NO. 1997 - 211

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND STAFFING LEVELS OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY FOR THE BUDGET YEAR 1997 AND TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 1996-179.

WHEREAS, the General Manager is granted the authority to upgrade or downgrade positions within the Authority provided the total number of positions approved in the budget is not exceeded. Furthermore, the General Manager may transfer positions from one department to another so long as the total number of positions approved in the budget is not exceeded.

WHEREAS, that administrative decisions were made during 1997 that affected employment needs of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

WHEREAS, these changes resulted in an increase to the staffing levels of 64 positions. And furthermore, these changes did not necessitate an increase in the overall expenditure appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the staffing levels of the 1997 Appropriations Budget of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 1996-179 during the period of January 1, 1997 through December 31, 1997, is hereby amended to reflect an increase in staffing from 2,932 positions to 2,996 positions as shown on the attached schedule by department and division.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon it's adoption by the Board of Trustees.
