

RESOLUTION NO. 1998- 3

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 97149 WITH TAYLOR TEAM OF DEALERSHIPS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) PICK UP TRUCK WITH SNOW PLOW THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,362.00. (RTA CAPITAL FUND - BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized utilization of the State Of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program in Resolution 1990-69; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Act provided political subdivisions within the State of Ohio with the opportunity to participate in contracts executed by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H) (4), permits the trustees of a regional transit authority to enter into agreements with the state; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of one (1) pick up truck with snow plow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority is authorized pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H) (4) to enter into a contract with Taylor Team of Dealerships, located at P.O. Box 10, 2510 North Memorial Drive, Lancaster, Ohio 43130, for the purchase of one (1) pick up truck with snow plow as specified in GDC-93-E expiring 9/30/98 of the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2. That the said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund, Bus Equipment Department Budget, in the amount of twenty nine thousand, three hundred sixty two & 00/100 dollars (\$29,362.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be a binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
