

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-16

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 97125 WITH SWIGER COIL SYSTEMS FOR THE FURNISHING OF REBUILDING OF RAPID TRANSIT ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, AS REQUIRED, FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$619,553.00 (RTA GENERAL FUND, RAIL EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Swiger Coil Systems located at 4677 Manufacturing Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44135 for the furnishing of Rebuilding of Rapid Transit Electrical Equipment for a period of two years, as required was received on the 7th of October 1997 for a price set forth in said bid of six hundred nineteen thousand five hundred fifty three & 00/100 dollars (\$619,553.00).

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Swiger Coil Systems, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Swiger Coil Systems, received on October 7, 1997 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Swiger Coil Systems for the furnishing of rebuilding of Rapid Transit Electrical Equipment for a period of two years, as required.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, in an amount not to exceed six hundred nineteen thousand five hundred fifty three & 00/100 dollars (\$619,553.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
