

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-70

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98045 WITH HARP CONTRACTORS INCORPORATED FOR PROJECT 7.68 – UNDERGROUND AND ABOVE GROUND STORAGE TANK UPGRADE, PHASE V - \$100,920.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND).

WHEREAS, the bid of Harp Contractors, Inc., located at 5222 Tractor Road – Unit G, Toledo, Ohio 43612 for the provision of underground and above ground storage tank upgrade was received on May 5, 1998 in the amount of one hundred thousand nine hundred twenty & 00/100 (\$100,920.00) dollars; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Harp Contractors, Inc. was the sole bid received; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code 306.43(b)(5), when fewer than two responsive bids are received, a regional transit authority may negotiate a price with the sole responsive bidder or may rescind the solicitation and procure under division (H) (2) of the section; and

WHEREAS, negotiations have occurred and the bid price of one hundred thousand nine hundred twenty & 00/100 (\$100,920.00) dollars has been determined to be fair and reasonable to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Harp Contractors, Inc. to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

Section 1. That the bid of Harp Contractors, Inc. for the provision of underground and above ground storage tank upgrade be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Harp Contractors, Inc. to provide underground and above ground storage tank upgrade under Project 7.68, Phase V.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in the amount of one hundred thousand nine hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$100,920.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
